

O12. CITY ULE Student Representation

1. Representation of Students

The student body of the CITY ULE shall be represented by:

- The CITY ULE Students Union; and
- The Academic Representatives of each cohort/class.

2. Appointment

CITY ULE Students Union Officers are elected by the entire student body.

Academic Representatives are elected by each cohort/class.

3. Term of office

CITY ULE Students Union Officers and Academic Representatives shall hold office for one academic year.

4. Duties and functions

CITY ULE Students Union Officers and Academic Representatives shall act as:

- a liaison between students and administration by efficiently communicating all relevant and important matters;
- the official voice of the students whenever any sort of opinion or stance is needed on the students' behalf

for the purposes of advancing students' learning experience by:

- representing the students of the CITY ULE to internal and external Boards, Committees, and Panels;
- organising services and activities to meet students' needs;
- providing opportunities for students' involvement and personal development;
- taking positive measures to encourage and build a student community which respects and celebrates the diversity of its membership;
- supporting the growth of the relationship between the University's and the CITY ULE's communities, as well as with the University of York Students Union.
