

O13. Contracts

Contracts made by or on behalf of the CITY ULE shall be validly made and binding on the CITY ULE if made as described in this section.

Persons entering into a contract, i.e. signing on behalf of the CITY ULE must have:

- (a) the requisite capacity and
- (b) the appropriate authority from the CITY ULE to do so.

Appropriate authority means that the CITY ULE has expressly conferred on a particular person (e.g. a member of the Executive Board) the authority to enter into a contract, as stipulated in the Statutes and Ordinances, other Regulations, Policy or committee terms of reference.

Any contract which, if concluded between private parties, would be required to be in written form according to law, may be concluded in writing by the person or entity referred to in the previous paragraph with their signature, handwritten or electronic, beneath the corporate name and seal of CITY ULE. It may also be modified and terminated in the same manner.
