

R1. Regulation on Awards of the University for CITY ULE programmes

1. Awards and Level of Qualification

The programmes offered by the CITY ULE lead to the following awards:

* The MPhil is awarded to Doctoral candidates who, for any reason, were unable to complete their PhD programme.

2. Exit Awards

The following awards are exit awards, i.e. after partial completion of programmes of studies, in order to match the University of York award regulations. If a student does not meet the progression or degree requirements, having exhausted all reassessment opportunities, they will be required to leave the University; students may be eligible for a lower exit award.

The exit awards are not recognised neither as Bachelor nor as Masters degrees respectively. This is stated explicitly in the Diploma Supplement.

3. Issuing of Degrees

The degrees are awarded directly by the University of York and are the same as those awarded to students who studied in the UK.

4. Academic Transcript and Diploma Supplement

Every graduate is entitled to receive a personal Academic Transcript and a Diploma Supplement, bearing the stamp and signature of the University of York.

An Academic Transcript lists the programme, award and all the modules or subjects which a student or graduate studied in each year, the marks or grades they achieved for each module and the credit value and level of each module.

The Diploma Supplement follows the model developed by the European Commission, Council of Europe and UNESCO/CEPES. The purpose of the supplement is to provide sufficient independent data to improve “transparency” and fair academic and professional recognition of qualifications. It provides the following information to all interested parties:

- The Diploma Supplement underlines that CITY ULE graduates’ degrees satisfy the three terms set by the European Union regarding the recognition of the academic and professional rights.
- All programmes offered at CITY ULE, University of York Europe Campus have been formally certified by the University of York.
- The formal qualification issued is the same as that which would have been awarded if the course had been followed entirely at the campus of the University of York in York, UK.
- According to the Framework for Higher Education Qualifications, the level of qualification for CITY ULE programmes, i.e. Undergraduate programmes (first cycle of studies) are assigned to level 6, Postgraduate programmes (second cycle of studies) are assigned to level 7 and Doctorate programmes (third cycle of studies) are assigned to level 8.
