

# R12. Regulation for Re-admission

## 1. Applicants previously failed at another University

Applications for admission received from students who have failed at another university shall be considered in the normal way, and may be accepted without special reference to the Senate. Application of credit transfer and recognition of prior learning policy apply.

## 2. Applicants previously failed at CITY ULE programme

### 2.1 Seeking re-admission to the same programme studied previously at CITY ULE.

If the enrollment has been terminated as academically unsatisfactory, other than where triggered by failure of the programme or failure to progress (see below), applications for re-admission must, if approved by the Departmental Academic Board concerned, be submitted as recommendations to the Senate.

If the enrollment has been terminated through failure to progress or the students have withdrawn from the programme, then applications for re-admission must be submitted as recommendations from the Departmental Academic Board to the Senate.

In the above cases, the application for re-admission should be submitted at least two years after the failure was confirmed.

### 2.2 Seeking re-admission to another programme

Applications for admission by transfer to another programme from students who have failed to progress and have been withdrawn, are not permitted. These students must reapply as new students for admission to another programme.
