

R5. Regulations for Entry and Enrollment Requirements for Doctorate Programmes

1. Enrollment Requirements

General doctoral degree requirements, including the required periods of enrolment for awards, are specified in the CITY ULE Policy on Doctoral Degrees.

Specific programme requirements are as approved by the CITY ULE and the University on the recommendation of the relevant School/Department concerned. Programme requirements are specified in relevant School/Departmental documents.

Students may not be enrolled at the same time for another research degree, unless such enrolment forms part of a collaborative programme of study approved by CITY ULE and the University.

Students are not normally permitted to count the same period of enrolment for the award of a doctoral degree and a taught degree unless this forms part of a programme of study approved by CITY ULE and the University.

2. General Entry Requirements

To be admitted on the CITY ULE doctoral programme, an applicant must:

- A. hold a relevant first degree awarded by a university recognised by CITY ULE or have other qualifications and/or experience recognised by the Doctoral Programme Board as equivalent;
- B. meet any other admissions requirements set out in the CITY ULE Policy on Doctoral Degrees.
