

# Scholarships for Undergraduate & Postgraduate Studies

The University of York Europe Campus offers full and/or partial scholarships to Greek students wishing to enroll in its undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes (excluding the Executive MBA programme, which is designed for business executives).

Scholarships are awarded under the following categories:

1. **Merit-based Scholarships (10%)**
2. **Need-based Scholarships (10%)**
3. **Scholarships based on both Merit and Need (100%, 50%)**

## 1. Partial Merit-Based Scholarship (10%)

- The scholarships provide a 10% tuition fee reduction for the full duration of the standard period of study of the programme.
- Scholarships cannot be combined or accumulated with other scholarships or discounts.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must meet one of the following criteria.

## 2. Partial Need-based Scholarships (10%)

- The scholarships provide a 10% tuition fee reduction for the full duration of the standard period of study of the programme.
- Scholarships cannot be combined or accumulated with other scholarships or discounts.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Low-income family (annual income below €30,000)
- Large family (three or more children)
- Single-parent family
- Migrant background
- Student with a medical condition
- Student with a disability

## 3. Full or Partial Scholarships based on combined Merit and Need (100%, 50%)

This category of scholarships is intended for candidates who demonstrate both strong academic performance and verified socioeconomic need.

The scholarships provide either a full tuition fee waiver (100%) or a partial tuition fee reduction (50%) for the full duration of the standard period of study of the programme.

Scholarships cannot be combined or accumulated with other scholarships or discounts.

### ➤ Full scholarships (100%)

Up to five full scholarships with a 100% tuition fee waiver will be awarded.

To be eligible, applicants must meet stricter academic performance and socioeconomic criteria:

#### **For undergraduate studies**

- Annual family income up to €15,000, or belonging to one of the following categories:

- Large family (three or more children)
- Single-parent family
- Single-parent family
- Student with a disability
- High School Leaving Certificate grade of 19/20 or above.
- Panhellenic Examination score of 16,000 points or above, depending on the field of study and the programme.

#### **For postgraduate studies**

- Annual family income up to €15,000.
- Bachelor's degree classification of 8/10 or above, or equivalent.

### ➤ Partial Scholarships (50%)

Up to five scholarships with a 50% tuition fee reduction will be awarded.

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

#### **For undergraduate studies**

- Annual family income up to €15,000, or belonging to one of the following categories:
  - Large family (three or more children)
  - Single-parent family
  - Migrant background
  - Student with a disability
- High school Leaving Certificate grade of 18/20 or above.
- Panhellenic Examination score between 14,000 and 16,000 points, depending on the field of study.

#### **For postgraduate studies**

- Annual family income up to €15,000.
- Bachelor's degree classification of 7/10 or above, or equivalent.

The final selection of scholarship recipients is carried out following an assessment of academic qualifications and the required supporting documents that verify the applicant's socioeconomic status.
