Entry Scholarships for students from Kosovo for the Academic Year 2026-2027

The University of York Europe Campus, on the basis of specific requirements described below, is offering **forty-five (45) partial scholarships of UP TO -40% on the standard fees** to students from Kosovo for Bachelors, Masters, and Executive MBA studies for the academic year 2026-27 (Start Date of the programmes: October 2026).

Under this initiative the University aims at supporting exceptional students who wish to study at the University of York Europe Campus and receive a globally recognized degree.

- Bachelors and Masters graduates will be awarded a degree from University of York
- MBA graduates will be awarded dual degree: one from University of York and one from University of Strasbourg
- The studies will be offered at the campus of the University of York Europe Campus in Thessaloniki, Greece

The University of York Europe Campus is a unique academic institution, widely recognized throughout the region for its educational excellence. It is the European Campus and a branch of the University of York. It offers a range of academic programmes, which lead to university degrees awarded by the University of York, UK. WHO CAN APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

All students from Kosovo are entitled to apply for a partial scholarship.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Candidates should submit the application forms and copies of **ALL the required documents**.
- If any document is in the Albanian Language, you are requested to submit a copy in Albanian and official translation of this document in English.
- All copies must be certified as genuine by a notary or an authorised translation agency.
- If a required document is missing, the Scholarships Committee has the right to reject this application.

Note:

Those who have not graduated yet but expect to have graduated by **15 September 2026** should submit all their available transcripts so far. The Scholarships Committee will decide on the basis of the academic proofs available at the time of selection. The Matura or the University / College degree must be submitted as soon as it has been issued.

PROCESS OF THE SELECTION OF SCHOLARS

1. Applications with ALL the required documents will be submitted in person to the university representatives on Saturday, 21 February 2026, 12.00 – 15.00 pm, at The Sirius Hotel in Prishtina.
2. Bachelors, Masters, and MBA applicants without any of the required English qualifications will be invited to take the English Language Test on the same date, at 3.00 pm. The test will be organised and supervised by the university representatives (Read about this English Test further down).
3. Applications will be examined by the Academic Departments of the University of York Europe Campus.
4. The final list of scholars will be decided by the Scholarships Committee of the University of York Europe Campus.
5. The results will be officially announced on the university's website.
6. All applicants will be informed by email accordingly.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The University of York Europe Campus is in charge of the selection process. The selection process will be executed by the Scholarships Committee based on its admissions requirements and regulations, as described in the relevant links below.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BACHELORS STUDIES

STANDARD FEES: 7,900 euros per year for any programme
(Plus a registration fee of 390 euros which will be paid after the candidate has accepted the offered scholarship)

The scholarships can be **UP TO -40 on the standard fees on the basis of certain criteria.**

ONE of the following criteria must be valid in order for a candidate to be eligible for a partial scholarship:

- Yearly family income up to 21,000 euros **OR**
- Member of family with 4+ children **OR**
- High school leaving certificate with a grade of 4.5 and above. If the grading system of your school is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-5 **OR**
- A bachelor's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**
- A master's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**
- Any special athletic or academic or social achievement

If you do not satisfy any of the above criteria but you would still like to apply for a partial scholarship, you may submit your application and the Scholarships Committee will examine your request.

IMPORTANT: Official documents certifying any of the above criteria must be submitted along with your application.

BACHELORS (UNDERGRADUATE) PROGRAMMES

The Bachelors studies last 4 years and the awarded partial scholarship will be valid for the duration of the 4 years, provided that the student shows good academic performance.

The partial scholarships will be up to -40% on the standard fees and are available for the following programmes:

School of Science / Psychology Department:

- BSc (Hons) in Psychology

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Beneficiaries of the scholarships are expected to be living in Thessaloniki during their studies. Students should therefore cover their travel, accommodation, and living expenses with their own finances.
- If a student-recipient of a scholarship does not attend the programme for any personal or other reason, then a student from the runner-up list will replace him / her.
- If a student is admitted on condition to provide some missing document, they shall be obligated to submit this document to the University the latest by 15 September 2026; otherwise they will be replaced by a student in the ranking list.

TERMS OF PAYMENT BY THE STUDENTS

For Bachelors programmes, payments for every year of study will be made in two (2) equal installments: by the end of September and by the end of February each year.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE BACHELORS SCHOLARSHIPS

Candidates for the Bachelors Scholarships should meet the admission requirements of the programme for which they are applying, as set by the University of York Europe Campus. Please read the **Admission and Application Requirements in the link below:**

- Candidates eligible for the undergraduate programmes should submit a High School Leaving Certificate (Matura based on the Law) both in Albanian and translated into English (official translation is required).
- Candidates must have good command of the English language, which is proven by an official test result (i.e. TOEFL or IELTS-Academic or Duolingo or an equivalent qualification / for a full list of the English qualifications acceptable by the University, please visit the *Admission and Application Requirements* link above).
- The English qualification must have been acquired within the last three years, taking into consideration the starting date of your course at the university.
- Candidates who have completed their high school studies through the medium of the English Language are not required to hold an English language qualification (a document of proof should be submitted e.g. a transcript or letter from the institution).

IMPORTANT:

Candidates who do not possess at the time of the application any of the above mentioned English Language Qualifications are eligible for the scholarships provided that they take the University's English Language Test, which will be organised by the university's representatives in Prishtina (read the information about the **English Language Testing** below).

However, after being accepted to the programme of their interest, the scholars must take the IELTS or TOEFL or Duolingo or equivalent test exams during the first year of their studies and achieve the required scores.

***THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE TESTING**

Applicants for scholarships who do not possess any of the English Language qualifications, as set by the University's Admissions Requirements, will be requested to take the University's English Language Test.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MASTERS STUDIES

All students from Kosovo are entitled to apply for a partial scholarship.

STANDARD FEES:

7,900 euros for most Master's courses – duration of studies is one year

Certain master's courses in Psychology which include internship have higher fees – read below in the table with the programmes

(Plus a registration fee of 390 euros which will be paid after the candidate has accepted the offered scholarship)

The scholarships can be UP TO -40 on the standard fees on the basis of certain criteria.

ONE of the following criteria must be valid in order for a candidate to be eligible for a partial scholarship:

- Yearly family income up to 21,000 euros **OR**
- Member of family with 4+ children **OR**
- A bachelor's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**
- A master's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**
- Any special athletic or academic or social achievement

- Beneficiaries of the scholarships for the master's programmes that are **taught during weekdays** are expected to be living in Thessaloniki during their studies. These students, therefore, should cover their travel, accommodation, and living expenses with their own finances.
- Students who enroll for a master programme that is **taught during weekends** may choose to travel to Thessaloniki for their weekend classes. This is applicable to the following programmes: MSc in Web and Mobile Development / MSc in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science / MSc in Business Analytics and Decision Sciences / MA in Applied Linguistics with TESOL
- If a student-recipient of a scholarship does not attend the programme for any personal or other reason, then a student from the runner-up list will replace him / her.
- If a student is admitted on condition to provide some missing document, they shall be obligated to submit the missing document to the University the latest by 15 September 2026, otherwise they will be replaced by a student in the ranking list.

Candidates for the Masters Scholarships should meet the admission requirements of the programme for which they are applying, as set by the University of York Europe Campus. Please read the **Admission and Application Requirements in the link below:**

- Candidates eligible for the postgraduate programmes are normally expected to hold, or expect to achieve, a Bachelor's Degree with a good overall grade from a University or an accredited college according to the Kosovo Law.
- Candidates must have good command of the English language, which is proven by an official test result (i.e. TOEFL or IELTS-Academic or Duolingo or an equivalent qualification / for a full list of the English qualifications acceptable by the University, please visit the Admission and Application Requirements link above).

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE EXECUTIVE MBA PROGRAMME

All students from Kosovo are entitled to apply for a partial scholarship.

STANDARD FEES: 17,500 euros – duration of studies is 2 years (including the dissertation)
(Plus a registration fee of 390 euros which will be paid after the candidate has accepted the offered scholarship)

The scholarships can be UP TO -40 on the standard fees on the basis of certain criteria.

ONE of the following criteria must be valid in order for a candidate to be eligible for a partial scholarship:

- Yearly family income up to 21,000 euros **OR**
- Member of family with 4+ children **OR**
- A bachelor's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**

- A master's degree with a grade of 8,5 and above. If the grading system of your university / college is different, the grade should be calculated in the scale of 1-10 **OR**
- Any special athletic or academic or social achievement

If you do not satisfy any of the above criteria but you would still like to apply for a partial scholarship, you may submit your application and the Scholarships Committee will examine your request.

The Pan-European Executive Dual Degree Master of Business Administration programme

The Pan-European Executive MBA programme is taught during nine long weekends (Friday, Saturday and Sunday), about once a month.

In addition, the programme requires participation in three international study trips:

- (a) a study week at the University of York, UK (for a long taught unit plus a seminar)
- (b) a study week at the University of Strasbourg, France (for a long taught unit)
- (c) a study week at the University of York Europe Campus, Greece (for two taught specialisation)

The programme is completed with the submission of a Dissertation or an Industrial Capstone Project. The duration of the programme is 24 months including the Dissertation or an Industrial Capstone Project.

Graduates will receive the following qualifications:

- The University of York (UK) degree
- The University of Strasbourg (France) degree
- The Chartered Management Institute (CMI) *Level 7* Diploma in Strategic Management and Leadership (optional)

The Executive MBA programme is delivered in two ways (two modes) and students can choose which mode to follow, according to their convenience:

- The Executive MBA Mode: 8 face-to-face, in-class delivery of courses in Thessaloniki, plus 1 course delivered online, plus the three international study weeks

OR

- The Executive MBA Blended Mode: synchronous online delivery of all 9 courses, plus the three international study weeks

The scholarships are available for the following MBA specializations:

- MBA in General Management
- MBA in Finance
- MBA in Marketing
- MBA in Logistics and Supply Chain Management
- MBA in Health Care Management
- MBA in Human Resource Management

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The scholarships are available for both modes of delivery of courses, i.e. **The Executive MBA Mode** and **The Executive MBA Blended Mode**.
- Travelling costs, accommodation, and personal expenses in Thessaloniki during the weekend courses will be covered by the student.
- Travelling costs, accommodation, and personal expenses during the study weeks to York, UK; to Strasbourg, France; and to Thessaloniki, Greece will be covered by the student.
- If a recipient of a scholarship does not attend the programme for any personal or other reason, then a student from the runner-up list will replace him / her.
- If a student is admitted on condition to provide some missing document, they shall be obligated to submit the missing document to the University the latest by 15 September 2026; otherwise they will be replaced by a student in the ranking list.

TERMS OF PAYMENT BY THE STUDENTS

For MBA programmes, payments by the students will be made in four (4) equal installments: by 30th October and by 15th March each year.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE MBA SCHOLARSHIPS

Candidates for the MBA Scholarships should meet the admission requirements of the programme, as set by the University of York Europe Campus. Please read the **Admission and Application Requirements in the link below**:

- Candidates eligible for the MBA programme are expected to hold a Bachelor's degree with a good overall grade from a University or an accredited college according to the Kosovo Law. The Bachelor's degree may be on any discipline.
- Candidates should have a minimum of three (3) years working experience.
- Candidates must have good command of the English language, which is proven by an official test result (i.e. TOEFL or IELTS-Academic or Duolingo or an equivalent qualification / for a full list of the English qualifications acceptable by the University, please visit the Admission and Application Requirements link above).
- The English qualification must have been acquired within the last three years, taking into consideration the starting date of the course at the University of York Europe Campus.

IMPORTANT:

MBA candidates who do not possess any of the above mentioned English Language Qualifications are eligible for the scholarships provided that they participate in the English Language Test, which will be organised by the university representatives in Prishtina (read about the **English Language Testing*** below).
